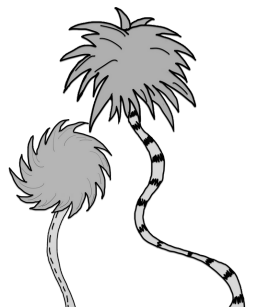

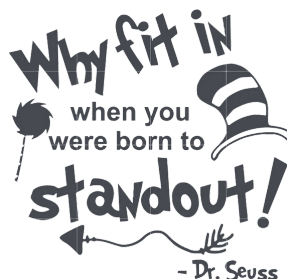
A Message to Our Students

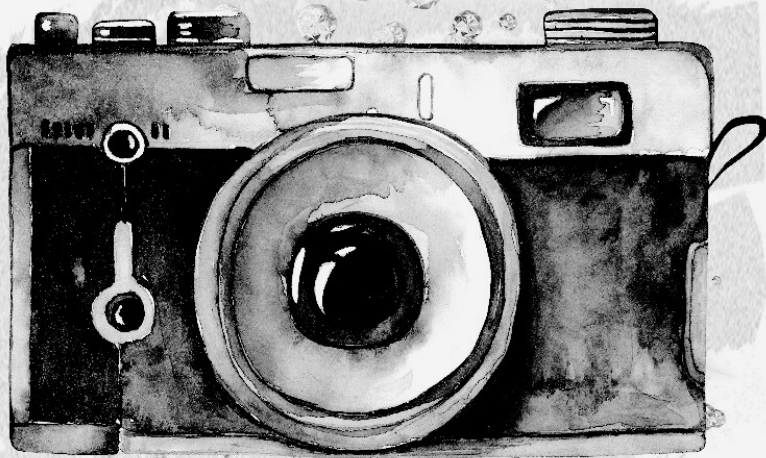

Princess Week \$50/week

Ages (3-6yrs) 5:45-6:30pm | June 26 - June 30 & July 31 - August 4
